Check-In for Your Housing Room

Check in will be handled at the Global Scholars Hall (GSH) Service Center on East 15th Avenue. There will be signs for the GSH Service Center. Check-In will be available 8am-8pm June 19-21, 2018 and then through conference organizers for the remaining days. Guest will be required to show ID upon check-in. For those driving, there will be a temporary drop off area for unloading and check-in until you receive further parking information and assistance at the Service Center.

What time is check out?

Check out is expected by Noon on the day of your departure. If you plan to check out on June 25, 2018 you can do so by 11AM that day.

How are the rooms set up? How many people can stay in each room?

University Housing residence halls are three and four-story buildings located on the east side of campus. Each room has two twin-sized beds, desk with chairs, and closets. We do not offer air-conditioned rooms, but summer nights in Eugene are typically comfortable. Each floor, accessible by stairwell in Hamilton Hall and accessible by stairwell or elevator in GSH and Kalapuya Ilihi. Majority of restrooms and showers are community except for Kalapuya Ilihi which has a private bathroom in each room. If you have a special accessibility need, please let us know. All rooms are double occupancy; sleeping bags are not allowed per fire regulation. Alcohol, smoking, open flames or pets are not permitted in the residence halls.

Are the rooms air-conditioned?

The rooms are not air-conditioned. Portable air conditioning units are not allowed within the residence halls, but guest are welcome to bring a small portable fan.

Are bed and bath linens provided?

Rooms are provided with sheets, blankets, pillows and towels. No sleeping bags will be allowed. Beds are made upon arrival. Daily towel service is provided, but do remember to **bring your own toiletries**.

How do meals work? Can I have a quest join me for a meal?

Rooms include a continental breakfast on each day of stay and each guest will be given a meal card that allows access to the dining facility at Global Scholars Hall. There is no refund for missed meals and the card in non-transferable. Guest may purchase additional individual meals with cash or debit/credit cards. Price for continental breakfast is as follows: \$9.95 per meal.

Is there internet access in the residence halls?

The University of Oregon does provide quest internet access. There will be instructions on how to create a quest account at the time of check-in.

Are there laundry machines?

All residence halls has card operated laundry facilities available for use by guests. You can purchase a laundry card at the Hamilton Hall or GSH Service Center.

Driving Directions to UO Campus

• From the Eugene Airport: Follow Highway 99 until it becomes West Seventh Avenue. Get in the right lane and follow West Seventh Avenue until it becomes Franklin Boulevard. Get in the right lane and follow Franklin Boulevard to the UO Campus. Turn Right on E Agate St into campus

- From Portland and the North: From I-5 South, take Exit 194B onto I-105 West. Take Exit 2, keep left and follow the signs to the UO. Proceed in the left lane over the Ferry Street Bridge, exiting onto Broadway, which becomes Franklin Boulevard. Follow Franklin Boulevard to the UO Campus. Turn Right on E Agate St into campus
- From Ashland and the South: From I-5 North, take Exit 192 for OR-99/Franklin Boulevard toward Eugene. Continue under the I-5 bridge and merge onto Franklin Boulevard OR-99/126. Continue in the right lane of Franklin Boulevard to E 13th Ave. Merge Left on E 13th (by Matthew Knight Arena) Turn Left on E Agate St into campus
- From the Oregon Coast: Take Highway 126 East until it becomes West Eleventh Avenue. Follow West Eleventh Avenue to Garfield Street and turn left. Take Garfield to West Seventh Avenue and turn right. Get in the right lane and follow West Seventh Avenue until it becomes Franklin Boulevard. Follow Franklin Boulevard to the UO Campus. Turn Right on E Agate St into campus
- From Bend and the east: Take Highway 126 West through Springfield which becomes I-105 in Eugene after you cross over I-5. Take Exit 2, the Coburg Road exit ramp; keep left at the fork in the ramp. Go straight onto southbound Coburg Road, which becomes the Ferry Street Bridge. Stay in the left lane on the bridge, exiting onto Broadway, which becomes Franklin Boulevard. Follow Franklin Boulevard to the UO Campus. Turn Right on E Agate St into campus
